

Jefunira Camp Tie Dyed T-shirts

Your child will be bringing home (or may have already brought home) their Jefunira Camp shirt. There are a few things you'll need to do before your children can wear it:

1. Soak the shirt in cool water. Wring it out well. This will help bleed out the extra dye.
2. Machine wash the shirt (by itself) in cold water to get any remaining dye out. To get the white portions whiter, wash the shirt several times before drying it. Once it is dried, the dye should be set.
3. The next time you wash the shirt you may want to wash it alone, just to be safe.
4. *We ask that campers wear their tie dye camp shirts on the first Thursday of the session for pictures.*
